COMMUNITY: Eugene is the second largest city in Oregon, and the greater metropolitan area has a population of over 150,000. It is located in the Willamette Valley and is the home of the University of Oregon. Marist draws from more than 30 middle schools, with some students commuting as far as 50 miles daily.

SCHOOL: Marist High School is a Catholic, co-educational institution offering a college preparatory curriculum. Expected Marist enrollment is approximately 512 for the 2011-2012 school year. It is accredited by the Northwest Association of Accredited Schools.

Marist follows a semester system with seven class periods. Each semester course has a value of .5 credits, with a total graduation requirement of 26 credits. In addition, 65 hours of Christian Service are required.
