COMMUNITY: Eugene is the second largest city in Oregon, and the greater metropolitan area has a population of

over 150,000. It is located in the Willamette Valley, home to the University of Oregon. Marist draws from more than 30 middle schools, with some students commuting as far as 50 miles daily.

SCHOOL: Marist High School is a Catholic, co-educational institution offering a college preparatory

curriculum. Expected Marist enrollment is approximately 526 for the 2012-2013 school year. It

is accredited by the Northwest Association of Accredited Schools.

Marist follows a semester system with seven class periods. Each semester course has a value of .5 credit, with a total graduation requirement of 26 credits. In addition, 65 hours of Christian
