Verano 2021 – Summer language engagement

Summer language engagement is essential because it is so easy to forget language skills without regular practice and exposure (use it or lose it!) We will discuss and review these engagement activities during the first weeks of class in September. Complete the following activities to practice your Spanish language skills over the summer.

1. Leer una novela. Read a novel in Spanish. (*¡El verano es el tiempo perfecto para gozar de un buen libro!*) Complete any three (3) of the activity options.

This summer’s reading:

Yo no soy tu perfecta hija Mexicana por Erika Sánchez

Lee la novela y entonces completa, en español, tres (3) actividades de la tabla:

<p>Tema: Identify a theme in the novel and decorate the page using color, fonts, quotes, and images to represent that theme.</p>	<p>Ensayo: Pick a major character and analyze how they change over the course of the novel.</p>	<p>Entre culturas: The protagonist, Julia, often feels caught between Mexican and American cultures. Observe and list products, practices, and perspectives of each culture that are represented in the novel.</p>
<p>Novela gráfica: Make a comic of one scene from the novel.</p>	<p>Escuchar: Use an audio book app to listen to at least one chapter to the novel. Write an essay and discuss how the audio version impacts the meaning.</p>	<p>Trama: Map out the plot of the novel using a plot map template (can find online) and add images.</p>
<p>Vocabulario vivo: Create a vocabulary list based on words in Spanish that are new to you while reading.</p>	<p>Elaborar: Chose a minor character that doesn’t get much detail in the novel and give them a backstory.</p>	<p>Cine: Plan out the novel as if you were going to make a movie / documentary version.</p>

2. ¡Y más! Leer, escuchar, ver y escribir. Log 5 to 10 additional hours reading, writing, listening, or viewing Spanish from authentic sources. Select any combination from the list of suggested stories, poems, podcasts, newspapers, music, TV programs, and movies. Track your work and time in the attached log.
