The 2022-2023 Annual Donor Report

Whether you are a current parent, grandparent, volunteer, alumni or alumni parent, you help keep Marist strong through your prayer, advocacy and financial support. We thank you!

The 2022-2023 school year was a momentous one. Thanks to your generosity, Marist benefited from a record-breaking fundraising year — nearly \$2.6 million was brought in! In addition to meeting the \$1.2 million needed for tuition assistance, this funding also helped provide for a variety of significant improvements.

Come to Marist and you might notice some changes:

- The first phase of our security project is complete. A glass curtain wall now spans our entrance while still providing visibility to the interior of the campus and our iconic fountain. Fencing between our buildings provides additional safeguards and helps secure our perimeter.
- A formerly blank wall near the chapel now blooms brightly with a mural honoring Our Lady of Guadalupe, painted by Marist students and a local artist.
- The wooden statue of Mary and baby Jesus in the grotto is now repaired and refinished.
- The floor of the main gym now shines with a lighter color and a large Marist M was added to the center.

Other exciting enhancements, though not as immediately evident, include:

- Our Academic Resource Center (ARC) now boasts a librarian who will help students and faculty access reliable sources of information, both online and through subscription publications.
- We continue to reap the benefits of, and have extended our partnership with *Challenge Success*, a Stanford-based consulting group, that addresses student mental health.
- Our students continue to deepen their understanding of what it is to be Marist by connecting with other Marist students from around the nation at retreats and conferences.

Of course, enrollment is also a key to success. The incoming Class of 2027 is 122 strong. Over 75% of St. Paul and O'Hara 8th graders have chosen to continue their Catholic education at Marist along with students from 16 other local middle schools. Marist is thriving and we are eternally grateful for the part that you play in our success.







Seven Decades of Dedication

Marist Brother Dan Grogan, FMS celebrates his 70th jubilee

"Brother Dan's celebrating 70 years? Did he join when he was a baby, robbed right out of the cradle?"

This question, asked in the context of Brother Dan Grogan's 70th jubilee, is not that far off the mark. Little Danny Grogan was 14 when his journey with the Marist Brothers began. Born in Queens, New York to Irish immigrants, Catholic education was important to his family. Naturally, they were supportive of their son's vocation.

Becoming a Marist Brother requires significant preparation. Danny and eight of his classmates from St. Agnes Catholic School spent their high school years in study and discernment with the Brothers at several Marist training houses (similar to seminaries). "It's a way of having young men investigate the [Marist] life in their own minds to see if they want to continue," explained Brother Dan. He decided he did.

He was 17 years old when he "received the cassock," donning the long black clerical garment that marks membership to the Marist order, and became "Brother Dan" on July 26, 1953 ... but not quite. After several additional years of preparation, he professed his final vows on the Feast of the Assumption, August 15, 1959, committing to a life of poverty, chastity and obedience. That same year, he graduated from Marist College with a Bachelor of Arts in American history.

Thus began a career in education that crisscrossed the country, including Brother Dan's arrival to Eugene in 1967. He was one of the few Brothers sent to help staff St. Francis High School while the new Catholic high school was being built across the river, aptly named "Marist" after the order that would be running it. Brother Dan served Marist from 1968 to 1975 and from 1981 to 1990. He was a teacher, a coach and an administrator often in charge of discipline.

One might not think a Brother with that last role would be fondly remembered, but he is.

Countless former students reminisce about detentions with Brother Dan whenever they get together. "I was Brother Dan's 'partner in discipline,' " recalls former student Ed Barclay '74. "When I was at Marist, my buddies and I mowed more lawns and pulled more weeds in detention than any of the staff. I heard this a lot: 'Mr. Backley, Mr. Backley [with Br. Dan's distinctive New York accent], we'll meet at 3:30!"

Brother Dan was strict but compassionate. He seemed to know the right balance for each student. "If kids thought they were being treated unfairly, look at their body language — back off. See them after school — don't prolong the agony in the classroom," he said. "I may have been ahead of my time then, but not anymore."

In fact, Brother Dan was embodying one of the more famous directives of St. Marcellin Champagnat, the founder of the Marist Brothers: To educate children you must love them first.

"Love of Work" is another characteristic of the Marist Brothers passed down from St. Marcellin. Early in his life with the Marists, Brother Dan worked on the Marist farms in New York and New England. Do not picture an idyllic orchard or symmetrical rows of sturdy corn — he once had to rescue a calf that had fallen in the manure pit. "The calf had gotten loose and fallen down the trapdoor into the pile and somebody had to go get it, and I did. I smelled like a rose!"

Here in Eugene, he was an integral part of the crew that landscaped the new school and built the Brothers' residence in 1975. Terrie (Tremaine) Clemens '69 remembers the Brothers in their cassocks with their sleeves rolled up, digging, cleaning, whatever needed to be done. "They taught us by their example how to work hard in the classroom, too, and how to follow through," she said.

But Brother Dan also enjoyed having fun. He loved Eastern Oregon and was nicknamed "the Bishop" by some of the ranchers he knew through his Marist Eugene connections. Brother Dan would saddle up, help on the roundup and assist with branding. He also liked to hunt and fish, once shooting at what he thought was a deer. "That mule was never the same again," said a source close to the mule.

Alumna Lex (Bonzer) Schmidt '70, who taught Art at Marist from 1977 to 2014, knew Brother Dan as a teacher, co-worker, vice principal and friend. "Brother Dan was intertwined in my Marist life," she recalls. "He was a big influence in our lives and the lives of so many others." He was even in Lex and Dave Schmidt's '73 wedding. "The first and last time I ever wore a tux," said Brother Dan.

Brother Dan served at six other Marist schools over his career, but we have a special place in his heart just as he has a special place in ours. He will always be here with us in Eugene, immortalized in a bronze statue standing guard at the entrance of the school with his iconic hands-on-hip stance.

"My time at Marist Eugene were the best years of my 70 years as a Marist Brother," he said. "I'd go back there tomorrow."
